Pants: hiking and/or shorts (or zip-leg pants)

Gloves	Travel pillow, pillowcase, or stuff sack
Hiking socks (wool blend or synthetic)	Chair/sit pad
Hats: sun and warm	Camp shoes
Bandana	Communication: cell phone or two-way radios
Boots or trail shoes	Binoculars
Gaiters	Wristwatch

Cooking Equipment/Food	
Pot, bowl, cup, utensils	
Pot gripper, can opener	
Stove, fuel, wind screen (share)	
Matches or lighter	
Water treatment: filter or purification

Warm beverage, electrolyte replacement
