Ten Essentials	Shelter
1. Navigation : Map, compass, ruler	Tent, poles, stakes and fly (share)
2. Sun protection: Sunglasses, sunscreen and lip balm	Ground cloth
3. Insulation: Extra clothing	Sleeping pad
4. Illumination: Headlamp or flashlight, extra batteries	Sleeping bag

5. First aid supplies : Including personal needs and toilet

Base layer: thermal top and bottom	Plastic bags for trash
Insulating layer: pants (fleece), jacket (fleece or down)	Dish towel
Outer layer: Rain jacket and rain pants	Lantern
Shirts: long and short sleeve	Camp chair
Pants: hiking and/or shorts (or zip-leg pants)	Shovel or spade
Underwear	Whistle
Gloves	Cord (25')
Hiking socks (wool blend or synthetic)	l
Hats: sun and warm	Luxuries
Bandana Bandana	Binoculars
Boots or trail shoes	Water bucket or bag, collapsible
Gaiters	Communication: cell phone or two-way radios
